- Decreased commitment to academic achievement
- Reduced achievement gains; limited progress relative to potential
- Less evidence of the struggle, persistence, or resilience that promotes continuous learning
- Decreased enthusiasm for schoolbased learning
- Hidden talents and abilities
- Fewer demonstrations of the personal satisfaction and self-esteem that evolve from opportunities to experience success with challenging academic tasks
- · Development of a fixed mindset
- Underdeveloped academic habits of mind
- Less productive and engaged lives
